

Fiji communicates via base stations

What radio stations are in Fiji?

The stations are Radio Fiji One and Bula FM (i-Taukei), Radio Fiji Two and Mirchi FM (Hindustani) and Gold FM and 2Day FM (English). Radio Fiji One and Radio Fiji Two are classified as public service broadcast stations governed under a contract between the government and the Fiji Broadcasting Corporation.

Where is Communications Fiji Limited located?

Communications Fiji Limited, a public listed company on the South Pacific Stock Exchange was established in 1996 and is located in 231 Waimanu Road, Suva. It broadcasts English speaking stations FM96 and LegendFM on 96.2FM and 98.6FM respectively, Fijian language station, VitiFM, Navtarang and Radio Sargam - Hindi speaking stations.

What telecommunications are available in Fiji?

Telecommunications in Fiji include radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet. 13 AM, 40 FM, and no shortwave stations (1998). Fiji TV, a publicly traded company on the South Pacific Stock Exchange, operates a free to air channel ever since its inception in 1994.

Where is BBC World Service Broadcasting in Fiji?

The BBC World Service broadcasts on 88.2 FM in the capital, Suva. Under the military government's Media Decree, the directors and 90 percent of the shareholders of locally based media must be citizens of, and permanently reside in Fiji.

What is Telecom Fiji's Fiber project?

Launched in 2023, Telecom Fiji's \$4.1 million Fiber Project is designed to expand the underground fiber optic network from Labasa to Savusavu, with the aim of improving internet services in Fiji's Northern regions.

Who is responsible for enforcing media laws in Fiji?

The Media Industry Development Authority of Fiji is responsible for enforcing these provisions. The authority has the power to investigate journalists and media outlets for alleged violations of the decree, including powers of search and seizure of equipment.
