



How big a solar panel should I use for a 32 watt circulation pump

How much wattage does a solar water pump need?

Let's say you want to pump water from a depth of 50 feet at a rate of 5 GPM using a 12V pump that is 70% efficient. The region receives an average of 6 hours of sunlight per day, and you want to use a 12V solar panel and battery. How much solar power does an AC pump need?
