



How much amperage should I buy for an outdoor power supply

How many amps on a 12V PSU?

Amps on 12V are like wattage. Make sure it's enough then forget about it. There are much more important aspects in a PSU. Most decent power supplies can supply 100% of their power on their 12v rail anyway. Your system is fine with a good 500w+PSU /41+amps. So it's like a counts? And this ~55A total?

Can I use 12AWG on a 15A circuit?

As far as a common 2-prong power tool, they don't care about 12AWG (20A) vs 14 AWG (15A) unless the cable run is fairly long. Punch it into a voltage drop calculator and see for yourself. You're perfectly allowed to use some or all 12AWG on a 15A circuit, if you want to reduce voltage drop.

What type of outdoor outlet should I Choose?

Where should a 20 amp outlet be installed?

20-amp outlets can transmit more power than 15-amp outlets. Therefore, 20-amp outlets must be installed in places like the kitchen, bathroom, and laundry room that normally house heavy-duty items like washing machines, hairdryers, and microwave ovens. You don't have a choice in the matter.

Can I use a 15 amp GFCI circuit outside?

You could probably use the 15 ampere basement circuit to power outdoor lighting, and water feature (just make sure it's all GFCI protected). If you're going to be using power tools outside (power washer, electric mower, trimmer, hedge clipper, etc). Then you're going to want to run a new 20 ampere GFCI protected circuit.
